		 a) A contextual plan is to be provided to show the site's relationship with the surrounding buildings. The Committee observed that the proposal cannot be studied in isolation i.e., it needs to be reviewed in conjunction with the surrounding facilities. Therefore, 3D views of the site shall be superimposed with the existing context of the surroundings including road networks, and structures around the site, for a better understanding of the proposal in the actual environment to make it clearer. b) Considering the site location in a heritage-rich environment, it is suggested that the design elements in the proposed design <i>(including canopy, glass in the windows, stone jaali, railings etc.)</i> be in harmony and integration with the existing heritage architectural form, elements, materials, specifications etc. The character of the existing surrounding buildings shall be reflected in the proposed design scheme. c) It was suggested to use energy-saving fittings and fixtures for all electrical appliances and sanitary fittings. 3. The architect is advised to adhere to all the above observations given by the HCC and furnish a pointwise incorporation & reply.

No changes are permitted on the external side/façade, the same should be restored back to its original heritage character, form in entirety.
c) The Concerned local body i.e., NDMC was requested to ensure its compliance before forwarding the proposal to HCC for its consideration.
d) Standardisation of the materials, colour scheme, colour grade, grooves, and overall originality of each element of the existing heritage structure be ensured by the NDMC.
e) Structural safety of the building should be ensured (including the roof).
f) It was suggested to use energy-saving fittings and fixtures for all electrical appliances and sanitary fittings.
