The Chairman of the Heritage Conservation Committee welcomed the Members. He emphasized the need for Heritage Conservation in Delhi and took a brief from the Members representing the DDA, NDMC and MCD regarding heritage conservation measures being taken by them.

The Chairman was of the view that it was necessary to ascertain as to which different agencies were doing work in this regard so as to harmonize the programme of various local bodies for Heritage Conservation.

Shri J.P. Joshi, Retired D.G of ASI informed the Committee that Mr. Babu, Director of Archaeological Survey of India has prepared an inventory of protected monuments in Delhi and further informed that the list of Heritage Buildings can be obtained from Shri Ratish Nanda and Shri O.P. Jain of INTACH who have prepared a set of two books in which all the Heritage Buildings of Delhi are listed. Chairman directed the Member-Secretary to procure three sets of books for the Committee.


It was decided that the following group will prepare a list of endangered buildings which need to be protected on top priority:-

Also it was decided that Mr. V.K. Bugga and Shri J.P. Joshi will prepare a directory of resources-persons. Member-Secretary (Secretary, DUAC) will provide support for carrying out these assignments.

It was pointed out by the Member-Secretary that a proposal of Old St. Stephen College had been received for approval from the MCD Town Planning Department, where provisional Heritage Conservation Committee was working. Committee decided that the concerned promoters and Architects be invited for presentation of the proposal at the next meeting.

It was decided that the next meeting may be held after a time of three weeks.
