 Shri B.K. Jain Director (DC&RYP)DDA The Chairman of the Heritage Conservation Committee welcomed the Members. He emphasized the need for Heritage Conservation in Delhi and took a brief from the Members representing the DDA, NDMC and MCD regarding heritage conservation measures being taken by them.

It was decided that the following group will prepare a list of endangered buildings which need to be protected on top priority:-

- 3. Shri Sanjib Sengupta, Chief Architect, NDMC

Also it was decided that Mr. V.K. Bugga and Shri J.P. Joshi will prepare a directory of resources-persons. Member-Secretary (Secretary, DUAC) will provide support for carrying out these assignments.
