## MINUTES OF THE 56<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF THE HERITAGE CONSERVATION COMMITTEE HELD ON MONDAY, MAY 29, 2017

## A. Proposals:

## Item No. 1: Permission for repair/renovation in respect of Shop No. 23, Ground floor, Regal Building, Connaught Place.

- 1. The proposal forwarded by the NDMC was scrutinised. It included the work in terms of the internal renovation like change in the flooring, temporary fixture/furniture, plastering of walls, patch work, false ceiling etc.
- 2. The proposal was found acceptable and approved with the following observations:
  - (i) The structural safety of the buildings should be ensured.
  - (ii) Heritage Character comprising of architectural elements such as arches, cornices, quoins, gables, architraves, palladian style windows etc. should be retained in the modifications.

## Addl. Item No.1: Change in incumbency of Central Public Information Officer (CPIO) and Assistant Central Public Information Officer (ACPIO) in respect of HCC.

The work of CPIO in respect of both DUAC & HCC was hitherto being handled by PS to Chairman. Considering that large number of applications seeking technical information are being received, the Delhi Urban Art Commission at its 1423<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on May 3, 2017 decided to entrust the work of CPIO to Shri Rajeev Kumar Gaur, Assistant Secretary (Technical) who will be assisted for this purpose by the following ACPIOs:

- 1. Smt. Uma Bhati, Architectural Assistant (for technical matters)
- 2. Shri V.K. Tyagi, Private Secretary (For Administrative matters)

The matter was discussed. As the Secretariat for both DUAC & HCC is common, the HCC decided to appoint the same officials as CPIO & ACPIOs respectively, for handling RTI matters relating to the HCC as well.
